






DANCE MOSAIC - A Celebration of Unity, Cultural Diversity, and Talent

Fire Drill Conducted at JKGISV

Earthquake Evacuation Drill

Mock evacuation drill was executed for the entire school to create awareness and preparedness during the earthquake on 4th September 2024. The students were trained to be alert, quick and responsible, follow instructions, maintain calm and avoid panic in advance by the school Interact Club and Disaster management club to avert stampede and casualties. The main aim of the drill was to build courage and confidence amongst students and develop leadership skills.

The staff members and the PET team positioned themselves at pre decided vantage points to guide and assist the students as soon as the alarm went off. The students quickly moved out in proper lines and were evacuated from the school building in 1 minute 56 seconds. Students were trained to reach the safe designated areas allocated for each class in case of any emergency. The main aim of the drill was to appraise everyone on how to perform – Drop Cover and Hold-on, a quake safe action designed to protect lives and prevent injuries from falling and flying objects.




